While all children are ministered to regardless of race, religion or sexual preference, special emphasis is directed to children from poor or troubled families.



Club Overview

Why Salesian? A Brief History

The name Salesian comes from the story of St. John Bosco who, as a young Italian priest, observed the unsettling influence that the Industrial Revolution was having on youth. Aware of the understanding and patience required with working with young people, St. John Bosco chose as his patron, St. Francis de Sales, who was noted for having conquered a fiery temper to achieve a gentle character. The family name Sales gave title to the Salesians of St. John Bosco.

In 1921, Fr. Oreste Trincheri came to the North Beach area and found that the Barbary Coast atmosphere created 60% of the city's delinquency, most notably in the neighborhood boys. Realizing the volatile, creative Italian character needed a positive outlet, Fr. Trincheri founded the Salesian Boys' Club in the spirit of St. John Bosco. In 1994, the Salesian Boys' Club merged with its sister Girls' Club, and thus, the Club came to be as it is now known: the Salesian Boys' and Girls' Club, a cornerstone of the North Beach community.

Club Membership is open to youth in the following age range:

MEMBERSHIP FEE

Membership fee is \$10 per year, renewable every August. Scholarships are available for youth who cannot afford to pay the membership dues.

Additional fees for special programs and field trips may apply.

CLUB STAFF

The Club and its programs are administered by experienced, CPR/First Aid certified and child safety compliant full-time and part-time staff whose mission is supporting our youth.

Some programs are run by community and professional leaders who are fully compliant for child safety.

CYO LEAGUE SPORTS

Members may participate in a variety of seasonal league sports including soccer, volleyball, baseball and basketball.



DAILY CLUB ACTIVITIES GAME ROOM, LOUNGE and YARD

Daily activities at the Club range from pick-up games to table tennis, ping pong, foosball, board games, homework, reading and socializing. Drop-in games occur in both the Club Lounge and Game Room, and, during any afternoon, Members can always find a pick-up game of foursquare, softball, soccer, or basketball in the yard or gym. Seasonal and holiday themed events are planned for Club Members throughout the year.



Club Guidelines & Rules

The Club is a drop-in youth center; it is not a day care center. Therefore, Club Members may come and go. They are not supervised outside the Club yard.

The Club will never refuse membership based on an inability to pay dues.

<u>Club Members must always be picked up by Club closing time</u>. If late, parents or guardians will be asked to pay a late fee upon pick up: the rate is \$1 per minute, charged in \$5.00 intervals. If a Member is not picked up by 30 minutes past closing, and there is no contact with parents or guardians, the Club will contact local police or Child Protective Services.

<u>Club Members must provide three emergency contact numbers upon joining or renewing membership</u>. The Club must be able to speak to a Member's parent or guardian within 30 minutes, at all times.

For the purpose of child safety, adults are allowed <u>only</u> in the Club Front Lobby and Main Office Area. Exceptions to this policy are: 1) child safety compliant coaches and volunteers and 2) parents and relatives attending CYO League games, theatre performances and special events

Children under the age of 8 are never allowed in the Club unless they are directly accompanied by their parents or guardians as outlined above.

Club Members must be in good standing at their schools to participate in all Club programs, including CYO League Athletics.

The Club will <u>not</u> store or hold personal belongings or money for members. All personal belongings should be kept on one's person or in one's backpack which should be stored in the appropriate cubby holes or program rooms. Storage of larger items (bikes, etc.) is done at the risk of the Member. The Club is not responsible for any personal belongings left behind.

Club Members may only use Club phones in an emergency and as directed by Club Staff.

Club Staff will not make arrangements for minors to schedule transportation in ride share services (Uber, Lyft etc.) or place minors in ride-share vehicles. Club Members may not use Club phones to make any ride-share arrangements.

Club Members who are sick and /or exhibit communicable and contagious symptoms will be sent home and cannot return to Club until they are symptom-free for 24 hours.

Participation in Club programs, activities and field trips may be determined by age, grade level, and group-size limitations, as well as a Member's individual behavior at Club. Signups are mostly conducted on first come, first served basis and written permission slips are usually required.

Club Guidelines & Rules

The following rules are based on safety, respect, and the Golden Rule: treat others as you would like to be treated. Violation of the following Club Rules <u>will result</u> in an immediate counseling session with Club Staff, and additionally, <u>may result</u> in suspension or expulsion from the Club.

- Club Members must respect themselves, the Club, Staff, and fellow Members at all times.
- 2. Club Members must behave safely and appropriately while at the Club.
- Club Members are allowed <u>only</u> in designated, supervised areas and should never be in an unsupervised room or hallway.
- 4. Club Members must use all Club property and equipment with care and in an appropriate manner. If a Club Member damages Club property or equipment, that Member will be asked to pay for its repair or replacement.
- Club Members must use bathrooms and dressing rooms according to their intended purpose only.
- 6. Club Members must keep the Club clean and use trash / recycling containers.
- Club Members may <u>not</u> use or ride skateboards, bicycles, scooters or skates
 etc. on Club premises. We recognize that some Club Members may ride those
 items to Club, however storing them is at their own risk.
- Club Members must wear appropriate clothing. Shirts an shoes must always be worn; caps, hats, or hoodies may not be worn inside the Club building.
- Club Members may <u>not</u> use abusive or threatening language, may not engage in fights, and may not demonstrate unsafe or threatening behavior.
- 10. Weapons of any kind are not allowed on the premises.
- Smoking, drug use, and alcohol use are <u>not</u> permitted by Club Members on Club premises.
- 12. Club Members are strongly discouraged from using mobile devices at Club. Use of mobile devices (cell phones, laptops, notebooks, gaming devices, etc.) is restricted to specific times and places, as directed by Club Staff.
- Club Members may <u>not</u> post online- or in social media inappropriate pictures or comments about Club Members or Staff.
