Dear Parents:

I just want to take this opportunity to thank all of you who attended our mandatory meeting on Wednesday, May 22. As you recall, we covered important Club policy issues regarding safety and parent volunteer requests.

For those of you did not attend the meeting, please understand that safety is the Club's biggest priority. Starting this Fall, we will implement the following changes in entrance / exit procedures at the Club:

- The Club has established a Safety Panel that will review the Club's member safety policy; the panel comprises Club Staff and parents from both SFUSD schools and SSPP and represents all member age groups.
- Members will receive a new membership card that will track daily summer attendance as we pilot new membership entry/exit procedures.
- This Fall, Club Staff will check in and out members as they enter and leave the Club.
- Some member age groups will be able to enter and exit at will and some age groups must stay on Club property until they go home.
- The Club Leadership will decide which member age groups will be allowed to come and go and which age groups will stay on Club property.

Secondly, we are launching *The Grigio Pack*, a PTO-like organization that comprises parents, family members and friends, the goals of which are to build community and support Club events and programs. We need your help as Club Volunteers and kindly request that each Club family participate in volunteer hours in service of the Club. A list of volunteer opportunities will be emailed in July. This list will include dates and times of projects and events; you will be given an opportunity to sign up for volunteer hours during when you renew your child's membership for 2019-2020.

If your child's membership is current at the Club, you must renew that membership by filling out a new form starting August 12. Membership cards will be required for all members and distributed at the mandatory August 28 Parent Meeting.
